PART - II consists of Descriptive Type Questions of 200 marks to be answered in 2 1/2 hours. There will be 10 questions of 20 marks each with extensiveness in each question.

C. SYLLABUS

PART I (OBJECTIVE TYPE)

General Awareness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matter of everyday conversation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries, especially pertaining to History, Indian Polity & Constitution, Social & Cultural History, Economics, General Policy, Science & Scientific Research, Nationalism/International Organizations/Institutions etc.

General English and General Hindi: In addition to the testing of candidates' Hindi & English Proficiency, the syllabus of General Intelligence includes questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.

Arithmetical and Numerical Ability: Questions in the form of Arithmetical and Numerical Ability will cover Number System including questions on Simplification, Fractions, Decimals, L.C.M., H.C.F., Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit & Loss, Discount, Simple & Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Tables & Graphs etc.

General English and General Hindi: In addition to the testing of candidates' Hindi & English Proficiency, the syllabus of General Intelligence includes questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.

Post specific subject related questions: The questions will be on the concerned subject/grade as prescribed in the recruitment rules and will be of the same level as applicable for the concerned post.

PART II (DESCRIPTIVE TYPE)

The questions will be on the concerned subject/grade/work/qualification of the relevant post as prescribed in the recruitment rules and will be of the same level as applicable for the concerned post.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

- In Objective Types Examination and Descriptive Type Examination, the questions will be bilingual in Hindi & English wherever necessary & except the test of language section of the paper.
- In Descriptive Type paper, the candidates will have to write the answers in either Hindi or English except for specific language question. The candidates will not be given any additional answer sheet.
- The questions will generally be on the minimum qualification level of the post concerned.
- There will be no negative marking for wrong answers in the Objective Type Exam.
- The minimum qualifying marks for Preliminary Exam is 40% for General and 30% for OBC/SC/ST candidates and for Main Exam it is 40% for General, 30% for OBC/SC/ST.
- Only one Admit Card for each candidate in the exam shall be dispatched to all the eligible candidates. The Board is not responsible for any postal delay/loss. If any candidate does not receive the admit card within the date specified as above, he/she may collect the Duplicate Admit Card from the Office of the Board, Reception Hall, FC-18, Institutional Area, Near Railway Retention Centre, Karkardooma, Delhi-110092 between 10.00 a.m. and 05.00 p.m. on the dates specified above. The candidate who comes to collect the Duplicate Admit Card, shall be required to submit the Acknowledgement Slip and/or any other proof of submitting the application form as well as proof of his/her identity. If any of the dates on which the duplicate admit card is being issued happens to be a public holiday, the counters would be opened on the next day.
- Candidates appearing for various exams conducted by DSSSB are being asked to note the following instructions for future compliance:
 - a candidate need not approach the board for corrections of mistakes in the admit card like spelling mistakes in candidate's name, father's name, correspondence address or wrong category.
 - They are required to bring an application regarding these errors at the examination centres itself and submit the same to their invigilators.
 - The errors will be corrected in the database before declaration of the results.
 - Candidates are required to approach the board on specified dates mentioned in the notice of the examination only in the following cases:

If a candidate receives more than one Admit Card for same post code, he/she should contact the office of the Board and get a single Admit Card issued. No later request after the above mentioned dates will be entertained. Therefore the candidates are advised to come to the office of the Board on the above date & time only.

6. Reporting time for the Candidates at the examination centre on the day of examination is between 09:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. for forenoon session & 01:30 PM to 2:30 PM for afternoon session. Entry to the Examination Centre will be closed at 10:00 AM for forenoon session & 2:30 PM for afternoon session. No candidate will be allowed to enter the Examination Centre after 10:00 A.M. for forenoon session & 2:30 PM for afternoon session under any circumstances.

10. The Board reserves the right to reject the candidature of any ineligible candidate at any stage of recruitment.

11. The candidature of the candidate to the written examination is entirely provisional and subject to the outcome of any order/direction/decision/order/pronouncement of any court of law and any issue of admit card or appearance at examination does not entitle him/her in any manner for the post.
